MEETING TIME AND PLACE:

09:00am Parking lot, behind the Niš National Theatre

09:30am The Skull Tower

The Skull Tower (Ćele Kula) is a monument unique in the world, visited by thousands of visitors each year. It is the tower made of human skulls, built after the battle for liberation of Niš in 1809. This horrific monument was built as a warning to anyone rising against the Ottoman Empire. Originally there were 952 skulls built into the tower, today there are 59 skulls remain and they still illustrate all the horror of the original tower.



10:00am Mediana

Mediana is a luxurious suburb of the ancient city of Naisus (today's Niš), which was built at the end of the 3rd and the beginning of the 4th century during the reign of the Roman emperor Constantine the Great and his successors. Today, Medijana is one of the most important archaeological parks in Serbia, where on an area of 40 hectares you can see the remains of a luxurious villa with a peristyle, the remains of two early Christian churches, parts of a granary, military barracks and water towers. Visitors can also see more than 1,000 square meters worth of floor mosaics, which evoke some of the opulence of this unique imperial residence.



11:30am Sicevo village

The village of Sicevo, is located at the beginning of the Sicevo Gorge 14km from the city of Nis. Famous as wine - growing village with long tradition there are many family wine cellars that are renewed and ready for the visitors. We will visit ethnic household “Ramonda Serbica” Inn and their wine cellar, the viewpoint, which offers a spectacular view of the Gorge and Nišava river, wher the viewpoint is overlooking the hydroelectric power plant built in 1931.



13:00pm Malca Winery with restaurant

A few kilometers from Niš, along the Niš Sofia highway, on the road of the Roman emperors Malča Cellar from 1903 represents a unique multi-century synthesis of wine routes that crossed, passed by, permeated and finally merged into a fairy tale worth mentioning in this area. The cellar tells that fairy tale through its unusual combination of tradition and culture of Roman emperors, Serbian rulers and old masters of wine. In the Malca winery, you can experience a journey through wine time, visiting 4 wine houses that differ in their architecture, the spirit of the times they depict, wine vessels and the way of wine production in them.
